





SEEKING AI/AN WOMEN AGES 18-28 FOR GROUP STUDY TO REDUCE ALCOHOL-EXPOSED PREGNANCIES





RECEIVI

CHOICES is an evidence-based intervention created by the CDC to prevent alcohol-exposed pregnancies by **decreasing risky drinking** behaviors and increasing contraceptive use.

Participation will involve completion of 3 online questionnaires and 4 group meetings at Tucson Indian Center.

Participants will receive a \$30 gift card after each completed survey, as well as \$60 in gift cards after completing the four group meetings.
