- Accepted formats: [PAPER SIZE, e.g., 8.5×11] original artwork, or digital files (JPEG, PNG, PDF, JPG)

4. ARTWORK RELEASE & WAIVER

Please read carefully and initial each statement below. For participants under 18, a parent or legal guardian must initial and sign.

_____ (initial) Original Work. I certify that the submitted artwork is my own original creation and does not copy or include copyrighted or AI generated material, trademarks, or the work of another artist.

_____ (initial) License to Reproduce. I grant the Tucson Indian Center a non-exclusive, royalty-free license to reproduce, resize, adapt, and print the submitted artwork on t-shirts and related Orange Shirt Day materials (including flyers, social media, and event signage) for community distribution and awareness purposes. I understand the shirts will be distributed to the community and not sold for profit by me, and that no royalties or payment will be provided beyond any prize awarded.

_____ (initial) Artist Credit. I understand the Tucson Indian Center will make reasonable efforts to credit the winning artist by name in connection with the design, unless I request otherwise.

_____ (initial) Ownership. I retain ownership of my original artwork. Physical submissions may be picked up after August 31, 2026 artwork not claimed by September 30, 2026 may not be returned.

_____ (initial) Publicity Release. I give permission for the Tucson Indian Center to photograph participants and artwork at contest-related events and use these images in newsletters, reports, websites, and social media.
